Elvis started the trip in his tank, but it was a little rough for him with the 2-3 footers we encountered so he ended up in his "travel cup" for most of the ride!


This photo just about sums up how we all felt this weekend – **relaxed!**

#### 4. Summer is in full swing!



relying on one car again!


The list continues...


